# **REGENT INSECTICIDE**

The following two products are specifically labeled for tank mixing with starter fertilizer (popup) and for in-furrow application on corn.

Continuous agitation is required. Follow all label instructions for mixing and use. Application systems that use direct injection of the insecticide into the fertilizer lines is recommended over tank mixing for the most trouble-free operation and maximum operator safety.

### **Regent® 4SC 1-Pass Application System**

BASF® recommends application equipment from REDBALL® or RHS® for the Regent 1-Pass System. Contact your insecticide dealer for complete information.

### **Capture® IFR™ LiquidReady™ System**

Check with your insecticide dealer for special equipment deals to apply Capture IFR. Currently FMC® has an arrangement with John Deere® dealers to install the Capture LiquidReady system on any brand of planter.

The following insecticides are labeled for in-furrow application, but not specifically with starter fertilizer. Their labels do not preclude tank mixing with starter fertilizer, but state that their products should be “jar tested” before tank mixing with other “agricultural” products. Always follow label instructions and any local or university information. Continuous agitation is recommended.

Important: When applying insecticide with liquid ‘pop-up’ starter fertilizer, inspect and repair the fertilizer application system if necessary to prevent surging problems. Rate of application must be uniform within the row and from one row to the next across the width of the planter. Use flow restrictors or other devices to insure that ‘dribbling’ on field ends is prevented.
